PST Invites Community Members and Media to Attend Gun Violence Vigil May 28 Warner Center Park in Woodland Hills Saturday, May 28th at 5pm

Following yet another preventable mass shooting at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas, Parents Supporting Teachers (PST), the largest parent advocacy group supporting Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) teachers and families stands in solidarity and support with the San Fernando Valley Local Group of Moms Demand Action for Gun Sense in America, which is part of a national grassroots movement fighting for public safety measures to protect people from gun violence.

The SFV Local Group invites all community members to honor all the lives lost this month from gun violence at a vigil and walk through in the San Fernando Valley. The vigil will take place Saturday, May 28, 2022, 5 pm Warner Center Park, 5800 Topanga Canyon Blvd. Woodland Hills, CA 91367.
